ALL RENT, STORAGE, AND ELECTRIC BILLS WILL BE DUE BETWEEN THE 1ST AND THE 5TH OF EVERY MONTH STARTING MARCH 1ST 2025

NO POST DATED CHECKS WILL BE EXCEPTED. ALL CHECKS ARE POSTED THE DAY SAME DAY WE RECEIVE THEM

HOME SELLERS: Anyone selling their home by owner or outside realtor **MUST** Sign an “IN-TENT TO SELL” Form before putting your home up for sale. Available in the main office or in the sales office.

PM OWNERS: If you plan to rent you're park model, please communicate with the main office. ALL perspective renters **Must** complete a background check before they move in

GULF CART OWNERS: Please follow the same rules as people in cars. Be aware of your surroundings, stop at all stop signs, etc.

TRASH: When throwing your trash in the dumpsters, please break your empty boxes down.

MAILBOXES: BE SURE YOUR NAME IS IN YOUR MAILBOX If you find an orange stick in your mailbox, catch the mail person for the reason. They will hold your mail for 10 days at the post office in Dewey. If it is over 30 days, they will return to sender. Please put in a change of address card at post office if you move. Dewey P.O. phone# 928-632-7291.

GUN OWNERS: Open carry of firearms and/or knives within the park is prohibited. Please refer to your rules and regulations.
